TEEN DIGITAL MEDIA LAB: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Teen Digital Media Lab?

Teen Digital Media Lab is a series of free design jam for teens where you and your friends hang out, eat pizza, and create. In each lab we will experiment with new tools and programs while solving fun design challenges. All technology and materials are provided, and no previous experience is necessary.

When does it meet?

Teen Digital Media Lab meets regularly on Fridays (usually twice a month, October-May) from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Where does it meet?

Teen Digital Media Lab meets at the Museum in the Nam June Paik Room / HBO Production Lab, located on the 3rd floor.

Who can attend?

Teens who are ages 14 and up. All levels of experience are welcome.

Can an adult attend?

Teen Digital Media Lab is a teen-only space. We request that no parents, teachers, or group leaders attend. Accompanying adults are free to explore the rest of the Museum during the design jam.

Can I bring my group?

We'd love to have participants from your program join us and would be thrilled if you can share information with them, but the event is designed for teens to attend independently, and we're not able to accommodate groups.
